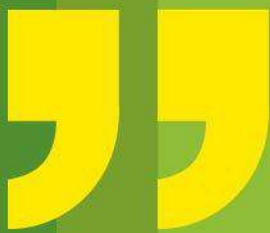

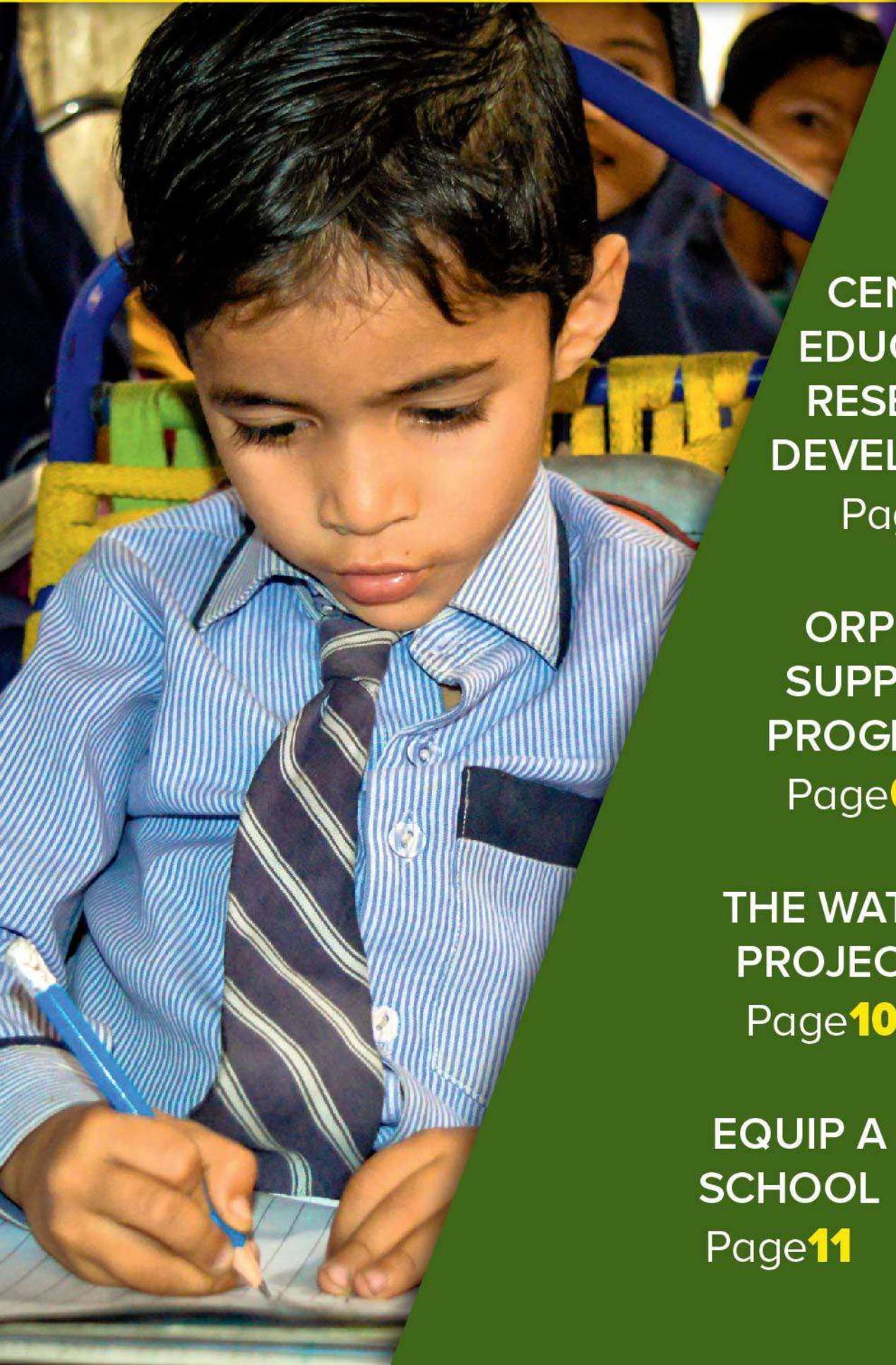

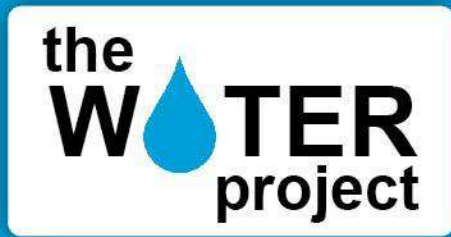
- Educational needs (Books, Stationery, Bags, Uniform, Shoes, etc.)

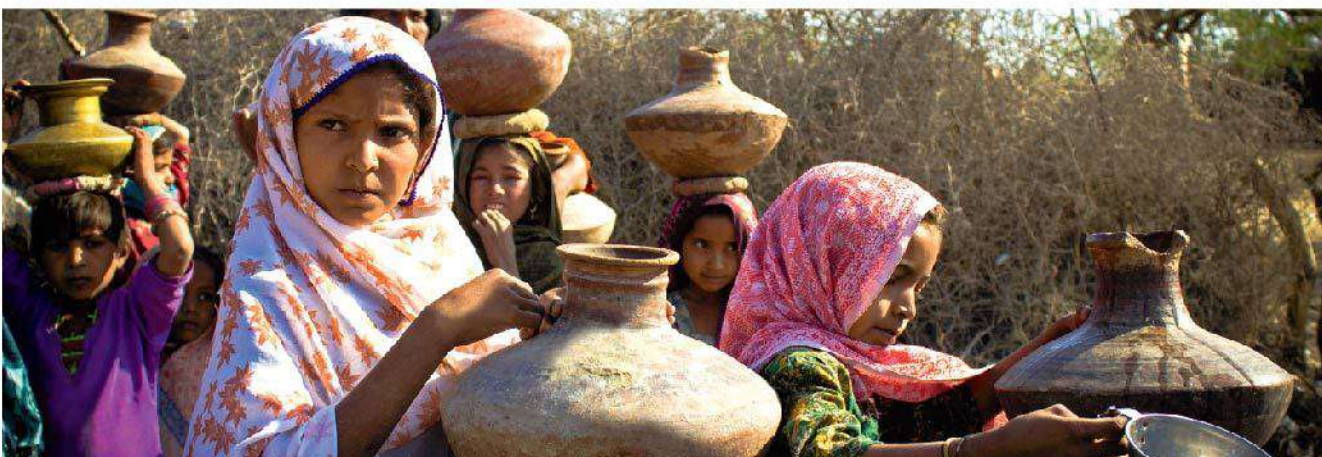
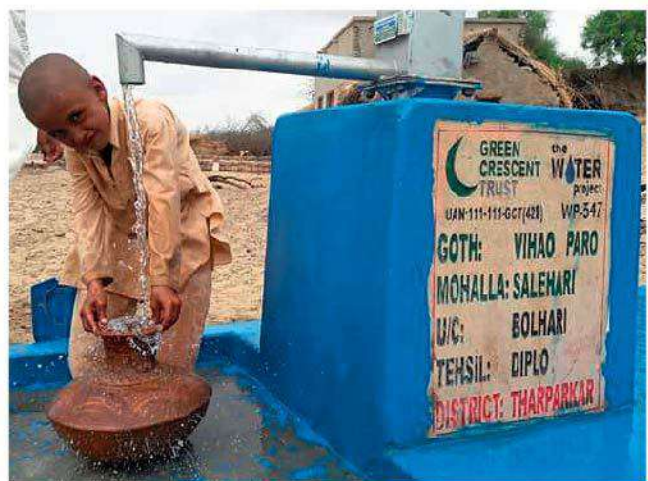


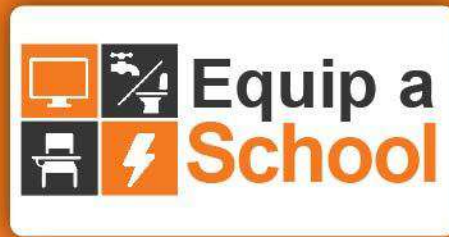

Young girls and their mothers often have to travel as many as 3 kilometers every day in scorching heat just to fetch one pot of drinking water for their families.

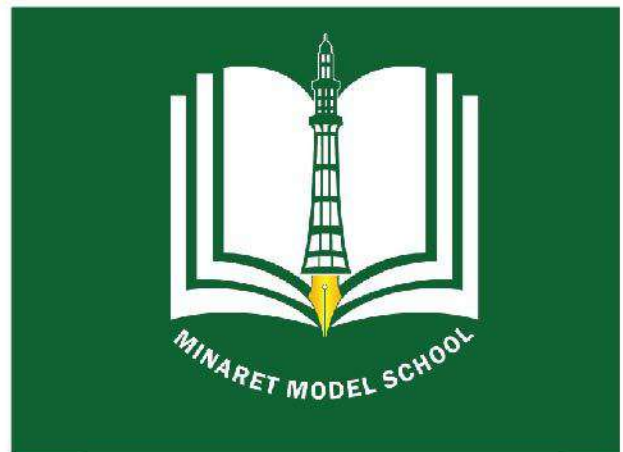
GCT BIDS FAREWELL TO ASIF SIDDIQUI
