Green Crescent Trust (GCT) is an NGO based in the province of Sindh, Pakistan. It was formed in 1995. GCT believes that together we can contribute for eradicating illiteracy and minimizing the number of out of school children in Sindh.



The dream of educating the deprived children of Sindh began with initiation of only one Hilal Public School and initial enrolment of only 65 students in the area of Gadap City, Karachi. It was then when GCT visualized accomplishing its mission and believed in the power of creating a team which caters to every aspect of this ongoing mission and the four core values of GCT.

GCT has initiated 350 water projects in District Tharparkar, benefitting around 90,000 Tharis. With the Water Project, each village we engage gets their own well, providing safe and reliable source of water right outside their homes.

GCT Book Bank provides books for the students who cannot afford to buy them. These books are protected with hard cover which enables its maximum usage up to three years. This increases utilization and reduce paper waste.

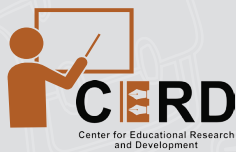

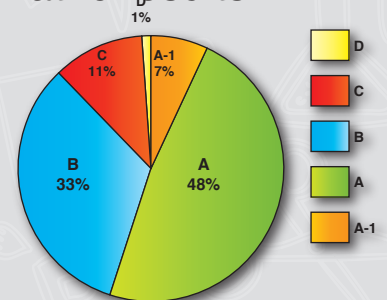

We hired 250 teachers and trained them to teach the children of the areas where the literacy rate is almost negligible. We also made our best efforts to provide every amenity to the orphan children and we were able to provide sponsorships to 400

orphans. Also we were able to initiate 120 water projects in Tharparkar to fulfill the basic necessity of water. Moreover, with the great efforts of our teachers and hard work of our precious students, we achieved outstanding matric results.

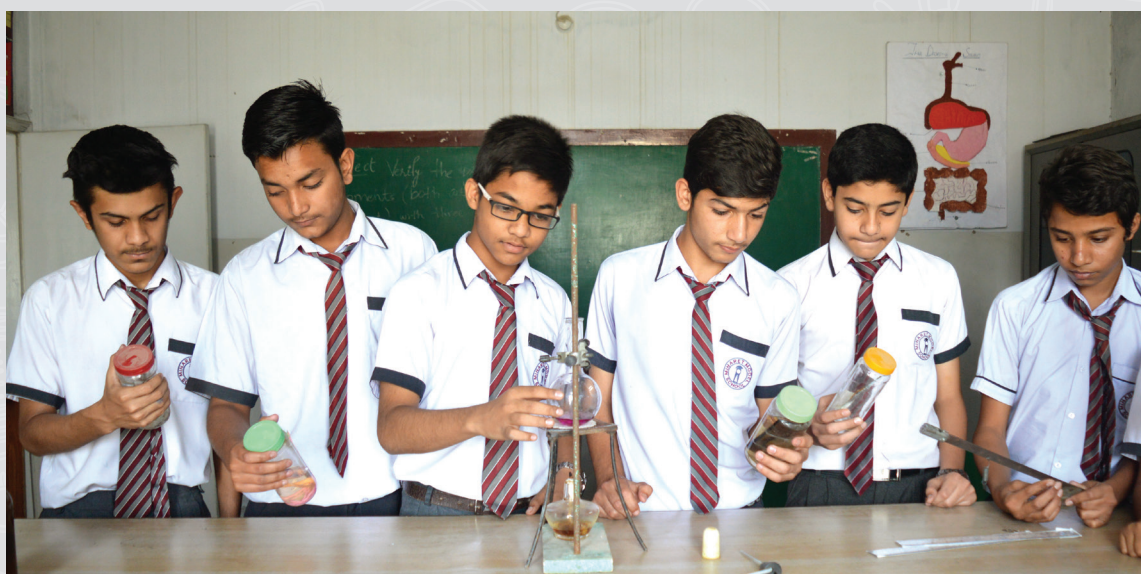


Minaret Model School

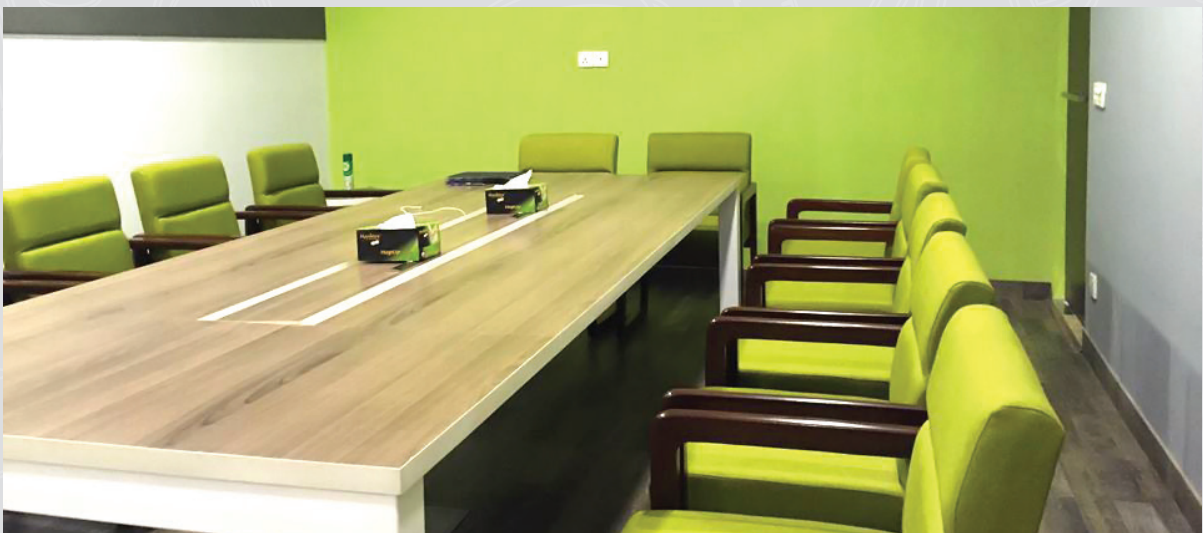
